

WINDSHIELD ILLUMINATING LIGHT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS PART # WLKIT

NOTE; THIS KIT WILL “NOT” FUNCTION ON
WINDSHIELDS THAT ARE TINTED IN ANY SHADE.

1. Clean the bottom edge of the windshield with a suitable cleaner.
2. Attach the chrome windshield light using the supplied hex key wrench for the 3 setscrews. The setscrews should be on the backside of the windshield with the wire to the left.
3. Mount the switch in a convenient location using the supplied primer and 2-sided adhesive pad. Apply the primer to the mounting surface of the switch and let it dry for 5 minutes. Remove the protector from one side of the adhesive pad and apply. Apply the primer on the motorcycle where the switch will be mounted and let it dry 5 minutes. Remove the protector from the adhesive pad and mount the switch.
4. Route the 2 conductor wire from the windshield light to where you have mounted the switch. Make sure you have provided enough slack to be able to turn the front wheel full left and full right without damaging the light or wires. Connect one wire of the switch to the colored wire of the light using one of the provided blue butt connector. Connect the second wire of the switch to one wire of the supplied fuse holder using the remaining blue butt connector. Connect the second wire of the fuse holder to the positive (+) battery terminal using a supplied fork connector.
5. Connect the BLACK wire of the light using a supplied fork terminal to a ground connection. (The negative (-) battery terminal or motorcycle frame.)
6. Secure all loose wires by using the supplied cable ties. Check the front wheel again to be sure there is enough wire slack for turning.
7. Turn your ignition on and push the light switch to test your Rivco “Windshield Illuminator Light”.

The windshield illuminator light draws a very small amount of power from the battery and can be left on without the engine running for several hours at a time without draining the battery.

NOTE; Do not use the light during rain or if your windshield is dirty from insects. Rain and insects tend to glow when the windshield light is on impairing your vision.
